Rigor, Relevance & Relationships.

This is a two-hour presentation on improving instruction by increasing rigor and relevance. A cadre of presenters is ready to join your school or department to guide your staff through these important concepts. Further professional development is also available to help your staff apply the concepts of rigor, relevance and relationships to their classrooms. Cost: \$500.

Career Clusters.

Perkins IV requires all recipients to develop a program of study, and alignment with the Career Clusters framework is recommended. How can you do this when staff are not knowledgeable about the concepts of Career Clusters how they can be implemented into everyday instruction? This two-hour presentation introduces the topics of Career Clusters and encourages both academic and career and technical education staff to bring relevance to the classroom. This presentation is available at no cost from your local Career Education Coordinator.

Creating a High-Performance Learning Culture.

These three one-hour presentations are designed to enhance administrator, educator and staff understanding of how school culture impacts student performance. The sessions also focus on how to reculture a school environment. Cost: \$500 plus expenses.

Effective Instructional Methods.

What are the most effective instructional methods that improve student achievement? This 2 1/2 hour presentation will assist teachers in using differentiated instruction in the classes. Cost: \$500 plus expenses.

Programs of Study.

What are programs of study? How do they benefit your students. This one-hour workshop will explain programs of study and how they enhance a student's course and career planning. Cost: \$500 plus expenses.

Meeting Certification Requirements.

Classes start in January around the state. The full range of coursework needed to meet temporary certification requirements is now available through MCCE and the University of Central Missouri. Regional cohort groups will be established, with classes offered in Kansas City, St. Louis, Cape Girardeau, Springfield and Columbia.

These courses are offered in a mix of online and in person instruction, with one to three in person meetings for each class. Classes start in January with T&OE4145 (Selection and Organization of Subject Matter for Career Technical Education), and the remaining required coursework will follow in a structured format to allow teachers to complete the teacher induction requirements with a supportive cohort group.
